

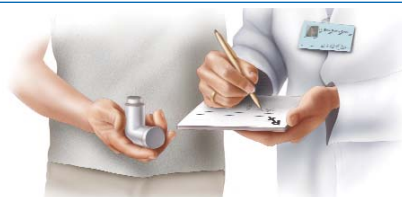
Questions to Ask My Doctor or Pharmacist

Make sure you understand your prescription. Don't be afraid to ask questions.

- What is the name of the medicine?
- How will the medicine help me?
- How and when do I take the medicine?
- How long do I take the medicine?
- What foods, drinks, other medicines, or activities should I avoid while I take this medicine?
- Will it cause problems with the other medicines, dietary supplements, or herbal supplements I take (including over-the-counter medicines)?
- What are the possible side effects?
- What should I do if side effects occur?
- When should the medicine start to work?
- What do I do if I miss a dose?
- How should I store the medicine (ie, should it be kept away from the sunlight? Can I take it out of the original package?)
- How often should I refill my prescription?
- Can I split or crush or chew my medicine?



What do you need to know to take your medicines as prescribed? Ask your doctor, nurse, or pharmacist for help.
