CODE CHANGES EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2009

Effective January 1, 2009 the administration codes for Therapeutic and Diagnostic injections have been changed. Please see the crosswalk for the code changes below. Please start using the new codes January 1, 2009.

96365	Intravenous infusion, for therapy, prophylaxis, or diagnosis (specify substance or drug); initial, up to one hour	90765
96366	Each additional hour (list separately in addition to code for primary procedure)	90766
96367	Additional sequential infusion, up to one hour (list separately in addition to code for primary procedure)	90767
96368	Concurrent infusion (list separately in addition to code for primary procedure). Report 96368 only once per encounter.	90768
96372	Therapeutic, prophylactic, or diagnostic injection (specify substance or drug); subcutaneous or intramuscular	90772
96374	Intravenous push, single or initial substance/drug	90774
96375	Each additional sequential intravenous push of a new substance/drug (list separately in addition to code for primary procedure)	90775
