FHCP's Pharmacy Benefit also covers certain preventive medications at no cost in accordance with the United States Preventative Task Force (USPSTF) Affordable Care Act A and B recommendations as long as all criteria are met and the medication is obtained from a FHCP owned and operated pharmacy.
